Messiah's Food Pantry has a history in Charles City as the Floyd County food box. It was originally set up in the court house with the Messiah Lutheran Church taking it over in the mid 1980's. Jordan River Church took over management in October of 2009 with the Pantry being housed within the Church at 102 North Main Street in Charles City. The pantry has over 50 passionate volunteers that keep it up and running for the approximate 1500 individuals per month it serves.
