


Feed Our Kids - Emmetsburg meets the needs of hungry children during the weekend, when other resources are not available. In Palo Alto County, 17% of children are food insecure. Children who qualify for the Free and Reduced Lunch Program at school are given an opportunity to receive a bag of nutritious, kid-friendly food. The program provides the children with a bag filled with four individual meals and two snacks. When children are nourished they are healthier, can focus easier, display better study habits, and are less likely to miss class.

Feed Our Kids - Emmetsburg Endowment Fund is a permanent endowment fund, meaning the fund is invested and grows over time, which provides a long-term, stable source of income to carry out the mission of Feed Our Kids.
