

Both Lynn and Sherry had teaching careers in the Algona schools. Lynn also served on the Iowa Lakes C.C. Board of Trustees and developed a high regard for the local community colleges.

After teaching for some time, Lynn was approached by a group of business owners who suggested Lynn run for Mayor. Lynn won his first election in 1997 and twenty-years later, he is still in office.

As Algona's long-time mayor, Kueck holds the City in high esteem and has dreams for its future. “I greatly hope to see Algona continue to prosper the way it is now.”
