

About the Grundy Center Kids Campus

Maroon & White Inc. is a nonprofit agency that was established in 2019 to rehabilitate the former Grundy Center High School into the Grundy Center Kids Campus. Once the project is completed, the Kids Campus will house the local Head Start office and programs, expanded enrollment for the Grundy Center Daycare and Preschool, and YMCA Before and After School Programs.

The original building, completed in 1938, is eligible for state and federal historic tax credits which will cover roughly 40% of the renovation costs. The remaining funding will come from municipal and school board contributions as well as local fundraising through the Grundy Center Kids Campus Fund.
