Marcia Bullerman and her husband, Joe, both grew up in small town Iowa; Marcia from Ossian, IA and Joe from Calmar, IA. They married on September 24, 1977, and raised their three boys, Ryan, Matt, and Bob, in Calmar where Joe has spent more than 40 years working on the family farm.

In June of 2015, Marcia was diagnosed with Glioblastoma, a malignant brain tumor. Marcia and Joe celebrated 40 years of marriage in September of 2017 and three short months later, Marcia passed away. Her memory and legacy live on.

During her fight with cancer, Marcia remained her usual optimistic self, while always showing concern for others. Marcia spent 30 years working for Luther College. She also dedicated much of her time to causes that were important to her. She volunteered at the local food pantry, United Way, was a member of a local sorority group called F.O.C.U.S., and was an active member of the Calmar Lutheran Church.

In Marcia's honor, her family has established the Marcia and Joe Bullerman Family Fund. The fund supports recommendations for grants to be made each year to support charitable causes that carry out the mission of the Winneshiek County Community Foundation.
