- Preference given to students who have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher.
- Preference given to students who are first generation in their family to attend college.
- Preference given to students with family of origin as residents of the following North Central Iowa counties: Kossuth, Emmet, Butler, Floyd, Franklin, Winnebago, Worth, Cerro Gordo, Hardin, Humboldt, Webster, Hamilton, Wright, and Hancock.
