LACES was established in 1995 in Independence with a diverse group of forward-thinking individuals to "promoting the arts to enrich life."

To date, LACES has impacted over 8,000 lives by providing fine arts programs for the schools and area residents including musical and theatrical performances, workshops, artist residencies, and community event sponsorships.

LACES has brought over 60 fine arts programs to Independence including notable artists such as Independence native and Boston Symphony member Chester Schmitz, state poet laureate Mary Swander, Iowa native and renowned opera singer Simon Estes, and, in 2017, the United States Navy Sea Chanters.
